

## Conditions of supply of Super Output Area boundaries

The Super Output Area Boundaries<sup>[1]</sup> are Crown copyright and are subject to the following conditions.

There is no restriction on the use of the material except that:

- a click-use licence<sup>[2]</sup> must be obtained for re-use and publication<sup>[3]</sup>;
- an end-user licence issued under a click-use licence must contain these terms and conditions;
- copyright and source must be acknowledged<sup>[4]</sup> on publication;
- the Super Output Area (SOA) boundaries here are in part derived from OS information, and some SOA boundaries which follow ward or parish boundaries reproduce limited parts of the OS Boundary-Line product.
